

UPDATED INFORMATION REGARDING IMMUNISATION

Our student health care policy requires parents/guardians to present children/s Australian Commonwealth Immunisation Register (ACIR) history statement when enrolling or was not provided when child was enrolled at school.

Then ACIR history statement only records immunisations administered until children turn seven years old.

However a record of early childhood immunisation is required by both primary and secondary school so that in case of an outbreak of vaccine preventable diseases such as measles for which children are immunised in early years, non-immunised students can be identified and we can inform the education department.


